## Free download for pdf to word converter full version

By Jamie Wilson Microsoft protects most of its products vigilantly, but at one point a version of MS Word was released online for free. The reason: It needed repairs because of the Y2K issue, and it was simpler and cheaper to distribute the fixed version free to everyone than it would have been to contact each individual user with a means to download and register the program. For those who need MS Word for specific projects, there are other solutions as well. Most online offers for free Microsoft Word programs are either illegal or misleading. Microsoft is very careful about protecting its ownership of products. However, one version of Word was released for free in 1999: Word 5.5. This version had a serious Y2K problem that, without a fix, corrupted every document created on it before the year 2000. Microsoft's cost analysis showed that it would be more expensive to contact each individual license holder than it would be to simply release the program. So they posted it on their site, free to download. There are some problems with this version. First, it is the last DOS-based MS Word, so computers running Windows 98 or later will only run it in the built-in DOS emulator. Windows 7 computers may not be able to run it at all without a downloaded DOS emulator like DOSBox. Second, it is no longer a supported version, so it's difficult to resolve problems it may cause and difficult to find documentation for it. A quick search on Amazon or Barnes & Noble does turn up some old how-to books on this version, however. download.microsoft.com/download/word97win/Wd55\_b997/WIN98/EN-US/Wd55\_ben.exe You may not have to download a copy of MS Word at all. If you have MS Works Suite on your computer, the word processor included is an older version of MS Word. Because of compatibility problems with Windows ME and earlier, no version later than Word 2002 was ever included, but this version is probably enough for most people. If you're looking for a cheap or free word processor that is compatible with MS Word, or if you are just looking for a word processor in general, the open-license Open Office is a good solution. This freeware product runs on most modern platforms with no problems, and it is mostly compatible with MS Word's format. Unless you're planning to do some heavy graphics work, team editing or similarly high-end word processor work, Open Office's word processor Write should work just fine for you. By Greyson Ferguson Omniform is a free-to-use computer program that allows you to convert a variety of different word-processing formats. This means if you currently have a PDF or Word Perfect file, you can easily convert it over into a Word file. This allows you to take files from just about any program, convert them, then open the files in Word as if the document had been composed in the Microsoft program. Download and install Omniform if you do not currently have it installed on your computer. You can download it from OmniFormat.com. OmniFormat supports all Windows formats from Windows 95 to Windows 7. Launch the Omniform software you have installed on the computer. Wait for the program to completely open, then click "File" followed by "Open." Select the document you want to convert to Word. Select a save location for your soon-to-be Word document. There is a pull-down menu available on the main screen for you to do this. You can select any location on your computer or attached memory device (such as a flash drive or external hard drive). Select the ".doc" format from the list available through the format pull-down menu. .Doc is the Word file format. Click "Convert" and the document is converted into a Microsoft Word format. You can now easily open it up in Word and edit it as if you had created the file in the program. By Louise Balle PDF (portable document format) files are convenient for sending and sharing online, but they are not made for editing. If the file is in Microsoft Word, you have more options when working with the file, and you can always convert it back to the portable PDF format later. While there is no simple "one step" way to convert a PDF file to look exactly like Microsoft Word, it is possible to do the conversion by copying and pasting elements between the two programs. Open the PDF document in Adobe Reader. Load Microsoft Word. Click "Tools" on the main menu then "Select & Zoom." Choose the "Snapshot Tool." Position your mouse at the very top corner of the page, click, and drag the tool down over the entire page. When you release the button the program will make a copy of your page. Go to Word and open a new document. Paste the image that you just took a snapshot of over to Word--the PDF file will now display in Word exactly as it did before. Copy the text from your PDF file first if your document has both text and images. Choose the "Select Tool" on the "Tools" menu, then use your mouse to select the text. Copy and paste it into its own separate Word file for now. Then go back and use the snapshot tool to copy and paste the images. Use the "Format Picture," "Size," "Text Wrapping," and "Format Autoshape" tool in Word to edit the image. Right-click the image to find these editing tools. Add a text box (or multiple ones) to the file that contains your image from the PDF. Copy and paste the text from your other Word file (see step five) into the text box. Edit the text so that it looks just like the PDF version. Repeat this action for each page in your PDF file. Open your PDF document in Adobe Acrobat as an alternative. Click "File" then "Save As" on the Acrobat main menu. Choose "Microsoft Word" from the "Type" drop down list and then save the file. You will still have to do some formatting as described in the previous steps. Microsoft has released a number of versions of this program since 1989. Often an older version of Word cannot read a document created with a subsequent one. For example, Word 2007 uses a novel XML (Extensible Markup Language) file format with the compression to reduce the file size. Fortunately every Microsoft Word program has an implemented option that allows you to convert a document to an older version format.
